Elementary School Announcements:

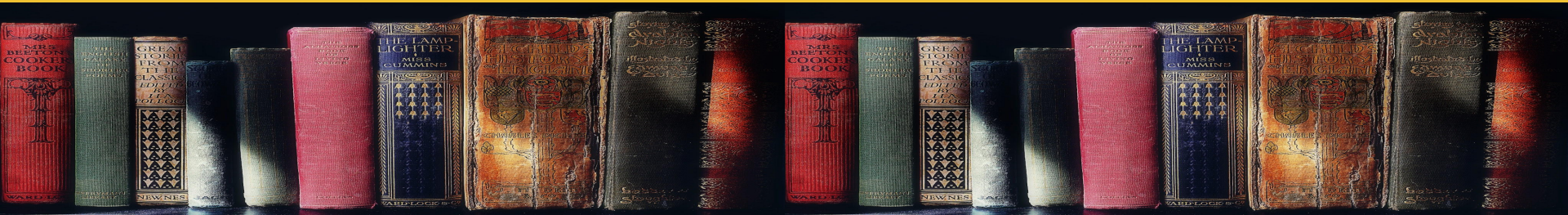

Middle School Announcements:

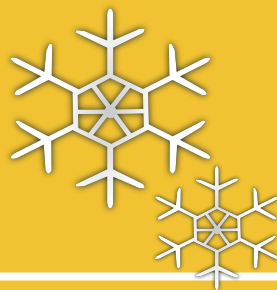
- 6th Grade field trip to the DaVinci Science Center is on March 7th, make sure your child turns in their permission slip.
