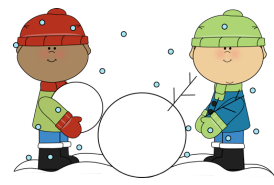

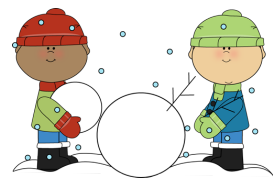
## How to Build a Snowman

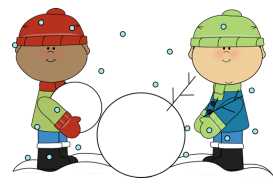
