Good afternoon, parents of current 9th-11th graders,

As we get closer to the end of the school year and are already planning the 2026-2027 school year, I want to share with you some information on end-of-year events, testing, and planning for next year. As we tell students all the time, the year is not over yet, and there is still hard work to do, but we want to keep everyone informed of these important dates.

Course Selection Process

Current 9th-11th Graders have selected their classes for the 2026-2027 School Year. The selection process is still open in PowerSchool. Please discuss with your child what they have selected and make any changes before the window closes on Monday, May 18, 2026.

AP Testing

May 6-21

Students who took an Advanced Placement (AP) course this year will complete their exams May 6-21. If students earn the passing grade required by their post-secondary school, they will earn 3 college credit hours for the respective course. Students are allowed to dress down on the day of their AP Exam.

Keystone Testing

The week of May 11-15, 9th and 10th grade students will be taking the Keystone Exams for Algebra, Biology, and English Language Arts. It is imperative that students come to school on time, well-rested, with their school-issued Chromebook and charger these days. Students are permitted to wear polos this week, instead of the uniform shirt and tie. They should bring a book or a magazine to read in case they finish before the end of the testing period.

Art Show/Talent Show

May 28, 5:00-7:00

Executive High School students will display the artwork they created throughout the school year in the auditorium. Students will have handmade items for sale. There will also be a talent show in Team 6 assembly at 5:00, which will run for about 45 minutes.

Finals Week

June 1-5

High School students will complete finals for all of their classes. These exams and projects affect GPAs and, in some cases, determine whether the student passes the class for the year. Please encourage your student to prepare well and take these exams seriously. High School students will be allowed to dismiss at 12:00 this entire week, as long as they have their own transportation, including parent pick up, walking, or LANTA bus. The rest of the school dismisses at the regularly scheduled time, and out-of-district transportation will run at its regularly scheduled time.

Credit Recovery

Students who fail a core class during the school year have the ability to make up the credit via an Apex online course over the summer. These online courses are condensed, self-paced, and completed independently. The cost to enroll in a credit recovery course is \$125.
