Executive Families and Staff,

We are writing to let you know that yesterday afternoon, Executive Education Elementary staff addressed a safety-related incident on campus. In accordance with Pennsylvania Act 44 of 2025, we are providing this notice to keep families informed and to ensure clear communication surrounding the incident.

At the conclusion of state testing, an elementary student was found cutting paper with an art blade that they brought from home. While the incident posed no safety threat, and was done without malice, immediate actions and protocols were followed to ensure student and staff safety. The art blade was immediately confiscated and removed from the school environment and the Principal and School Safety and Security Coordinator were immediately notified. Regular school operations continued as normal.

Pennsylvania Act 44 of 2025, requires schools to notify parents/guardians and employees whenever staff respond to an incident involving a weapon on school property, at a school-sponsored event, or on school transportation. Due to the law's privacy restrictions, schools are not permitted to share any details beyond the legally approved message and cannot provide additional details or personally identifiable information. Executive Education Academy Charter School will maintain compliance with state and federal laws, including FERPA, and ensure protection and privacy of students and staff.

We remain committed to maintaining a safe and secure learning environment and appreciate your continued partnership in reinforcing our safety and security expectations with your children.
