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## **Pledge Package**

This pledge package was developed to help you become a member of Executive Education Academy Charter School's student government. The members of the student government club are students that model the normative culture, academic achievement, and career awareness. These students consistently redirect negative behavior, excel in the classroom, and support staff. These students embody the essence of Executive Education Academy Charter School by helping themselves and helping others. This group will support you in developing positive behavior and leadership skills that will help you while at EEACS.

### **How to Become a Member of the Student Government Club**

1. Show positive behavior in the classroom, cafeteria, hallways, assembly, and during all transitions.
2. Share with all faculty that you want to become a member of the Student Government Club.
3. Speak to Student Government members and express your interest in becoming a part of the Student Government club.
4. When your homeroom teacher, subject teachers, lead teacher, and Team Leader agree that you have been demonstrating consistent, positive behavior, you will be given a Pledge Log.
5. Your Student Government Club Peer Mentor will read through the Pledge Log with you and explain it to you.
6. Your Student Government Peer Mentor and the Student Government Advisor will help you whenever you may have questions or concerns with your Pledge Packet.
7. When you finished your Student Government Club Pledge Packet, your Student Government Peer Mentor and you should bring it to your Student Government Advisor which will be brought up in Team Meeting for evaluation.
8. You will be pledged into Student Government Club in front of your peers in afternoon assembly.
9. As a member of the club you will help us make EEACS a better school each and every day.

10. Student Government members are role models for the school, a positive influence on their peers, and remain focused on achieving individual and school wide goals.

### **The Student Government Club Pledge Log**

Your Student Government Peer Mentor can help you with any part of the log that may be difficult for you to complete, just ask for help. There are instructions for each section. Show your Student Government Advisor your Pledge Log as you are working on it. The Student Government Pledge Log should take you at least two weeks to complete.

### **Redirection Pages**

The redirection pages are to help you develop a positive redirection style. Redirect your peers in a proper and respectful manner. Always try to redirect in a manner that you would want to be redirected. Start with the lowest level of redirection needed for the situation. The levels of student redirection are:

Friendly Non-Verbal  
Concern Non-Verbal  
Helpful Verbal  
Concern Verbal  
Student/Staff Support

You should only complete one page each day. Write down 10 redirections and have the peer you redirected sign the redirection page. You write down the redirection and have your peer sign the redirection page with their initials. The person being redirected must sign the log. If the student decides not to sign the log, then your process must be followed. Make sure to know your process.

Following are some common redirections that you may make. These are just some examples to get you started.

Please tuck your shirt in.  
Around here we don't disrespect one another.  
Around here we don't horseplay.  
Please pick up your trash.  
Around here we use scholarly language.  
Around here we clean up after ourselves.  
Please push in your chair.  
Remember to say thank you.  
Please transition quietly.

Remember to redirect in a positive manner and be a role model. That means to accept all redirections right or wrong, weak, or strong.
