It is the beginning of May and I wanted to send out some information regarding end of year activities for the senior class.

May 5th-15th:

AP Testing: For those students who are taking an Advanced Placement class this year.

May 21st:

What's Next Wednesday: 2:00 PM Team 6 Assembly: Parents and students are invited to attend. This is an afternoon to celebrate the soon-to-be graduates and reflect on their memories from Executive and what their plan is after graduation. With graduation being a day of hearing your child's name along with all of the other graduates, What's Next Wednesday allows for a more personalized moment of celebration. At the conclusion of this event some scholarships will be awarded from the EEACS Foundation and LVHN Health Network.

May 23rd:

Cap and Gown Distribution: All seniors attending prom must be in school that day. Since we know many students have hair and other appointments during the day to get ready to look their best, we will have a senior assembly at 9:00am where we distribute each student's cap and gown. Once this is complete, seniors are allowed to leave the building to prep for prom. (Please notify Mr. Reiss if you do not want your child dismissing early).

May 23rd:

Senior Prom: 7:00pm-11:00pm at The Club at Twin Lakes: Students must arrive by 8:00 or will be denied entry if they do not communicate ahead of time. Students may drive themselves or be dropped off. Parents are welcome to take pictures of students as they arrive but are not permitted inside the ballroom.

June 2nd-5th:

Finals: All high school students will take their finals on these dates. These are important for grades/GPA's and in some cases whether your child will pass their class and graduate. At the conclusion of students finals seniors will turn in their school issued chromebook. Students who do not will have their diploma held until they pay the fee.



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June 9th:

Senior Breakfast and Graduation Practice: Seniors will eat one more meal in the cafeteria and have few moments to spend with each other and their teachers. At the conclusion of this they will board buses and head to Symphony Hall for graduation practice. They will return to school in time for dismissal (12:00 that day).

June 10th:

Graduation Ceremony: 6:00 pm Symphony Hall, Allentown: Graduates will arrive between 4:45-5:00 to prepare for the ceremony. Doors open at 5:00 for ticket holders. All graduates will be given eight (8) tickets for family and friends. We will accommodate special requests after all students have their tickets. There is a seating capacity of about 1,000 at the venue, last year everyone who needed extra tickets was able to be accommodated.

It surely is a busy and exciting time in these students' lives, we look forward to celebrating with them as they move on to exciting post secondary lives!
